Welcome to Hodgdon Middle/High School! A place that prides itself in the mission of providing teachers and students a small family atmosphere with innovative and rigorous learning where all can reach their fullest potential. Our quality of instruction and attention to each individual's need provides for student centered and reality based skill development through each of our offered opportunities.

Our team of professionals share the vision of providing an enriching educational experience where our course content has been developed to provide learning tools and/or skills that are needed in everyday life. In addition to our traditional class offerings, Hodgdon Middle/High School offers dual credits through the University of Maine at Presque Isle. Students who successfully complete AP US History will receive three college credits each for HTY 161 and HTY 162; in English Literature/Composition three credits each for ENG 101 and ENG 151; in Anatomy and Physiology four credits each for BIO 261 and BIO 262; in AP Chemistry four credits each for CHY 111 and CHY 122, and in AP Biology they will receive four credits for BIO 112. Eligible students have the opportunity to participate in Maine's Aspirations for Early College Program thus having 12 credits paid for by the State of Maine. Hodgdon students regularly take advantage of this program through UMPI, UMFK, UMM, UMA, Husson, or NMCC. Students are also encouraged to participate in our Regional Two-School of Applied Technology where they gain credits through a more hands-on approach to learning of the trades.

Hodgdon Middle/High School offers students in strong academic standing the opportunity to participate in a variety of varsity, junior varsity, and inter-league sports with the inclusion of golf, soccer, football, basketball, ice hockey, cheering, volleyball, cross country running, track, baseball, and softball. Additional clubs are formed each year based on student interests and have included that of Esports, Chess, Future Farmers of America, Envirothon, Civil Rights, National Honor Society, Student Council and more.

As a school, in collaboration with the community and home, we commit ourselves to being a society of learners who exemplify integrity, respect, and courage in order to ensure the success of students in school and in the future.
